

## What Can I Do?

- **Vote! Primary Day is September 20.** More votes for Rick Feldman for Mayor will insure that we have a full debate and discussion during the rest of this election campaign about all the issues and concerns we never get to talk about.
- **Talk to friends and neighbors about Rick Feldman.** Tell them that he will bring change to City Hall. Tell them that he will provide the new leadership needed to prepare Northampton for the future. Tell them that he listens --- that he visits neighborhoods, attends discussions, take calls, and learns from everyone. Tell them that he takes all people seriously, and takes their ideas, opinions, and concerns to heart. Tell them that he will get accomplishments in new revenues, spending controls, open space protection, business support, new economic growth and security, and education. Tell that he wants to be accountable. Tell them about his Citizens Report Card: a way for people to monitor and grade City Hall performance. Tell them that this Mayor will care, listen, act, and accomplish, and that we --- all of us --- will work together to make this the city we want.
- **Write letters to the editor of local newspapers.**
- **Hold signs before primary day.**
- **Holds signs at polling places.**
- **Post a lawn sign.**
- **Contact Rick and his campaign:** let him know what you think, what you care about, what you want to see happen! He wants to hear from you.
- **Take Rick around your ward, precinct, or neighborhood to meet others and to talk with them about the future of our city.**
- **Distribute brochures and other hand-outs.**
- **Advise the campaign:** again, contact Rick through email or telephone.
- **Host a coffee-tea and discussion session; bring in the neighbors.**
